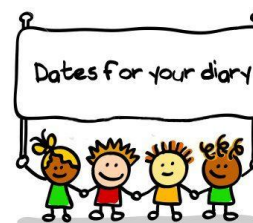
Breakfast Club- 8am-8.50am £3.50 per child per session
