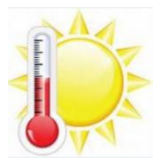

## **School Uniform**

As we come towards the end of the school year, many parents start to think about getting uniform ready for the new school year in September. Please see below for a reminder of our school uniform policy.

**Our school uniform consists of:**

Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan (with or without the school logo)

White or navy-blue polo shirt

Black trousers, skirt or dress

Black tights, black or white socks

In summer, a plain blue and white gingham school dress can be worn or black school shorts with no additional colours, badges or adornments.



### **Footwear**

School footwear is appropriate black shoes, **not trainers**.

### **PE Kit**

Plain black shorts, plain white T-shirt and trainers or plimsolls

Outdoor games kit includes a warm jogging top, tracksuit bottoms and trainers suitable for outdoor use.

**All clothing and shoes should be labelled with your child's name.**

Hair that touches a child's shoulders must be tied up. Patterned shaved hairstyles and dyed hair are not appropriate for school.

Jewellery should not be worn as there is a danger that it may be caught on equipment. Children with pierced ears should only wear small, plain stud earrings with no adornment which must be removed or covered with surgical tape for PE lessons. Children may wear a watch but no smart watches are to be worn. No nail varnish or make up is allowed.

However, for all general communication I would be grateful if you could contact me before 6pm or wait until the next day.

All general communication should primarily go through the school office in the first instance.

## Breakfast and After School Club

The clubs have now started this week and booking is available via School Money. A letter has been sent out to all parents with further information. If you wish to book your child into the club, please ensure you have completed and returned the Wraparound Care Contract and Contact Form.

As the provision will be run by school staff, the times and fees will be as follows:

Breakfast Club- 8am-8.50am      £3.50 per child per session

After School Club- 3.30pm-5.30pm      £6.50 per child per session



Payment must be made before your child attends the club and children can be booked into either club up to midnight the night before. We hope that families will support the provision so that we can keep make it a long term childcare provision to support all of our families. For further information, please contact the school office.

## School Car Park

Please be reminded that from Monday 30th June, the school car park must not be used by any parents or carers when dropping children off or collecting children from clubs. This includes breakfast, after school, Kids with Bricks and gymnastics club.



If you have a prior agreement made with the school to use the car park, this only applies for normal school hours at 9am and 3.30pm, please do not use the carpark outside of these times.

Nursery parents collecting children at 12pm are also reminded that they should not use the school car park when collecting their children at lunchtime.

Please use the roads around the school to park and walk into school. This is to avoid congestion and for health and safety reasons.

Parents/carers are invited to join us at 1.15pm ready for a 1.30pm start. The afternoon will be organised by the fantastic coaches at Fit4Fun. Please ensure your child wears their colour t-shirt to school on that day with their PE shorts and trainers. All children must have trainers for safety reasons. Please can we ask that you send your child to school with a sunhat, water bottle and with suncream applied.

Children will be sat in a shaded area. Please can we remind parents/carers that they should stay in the designated spectator area and not come across to where the children are sitting.

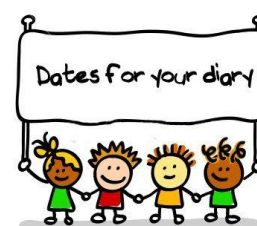
