School Lunches

Please continue to book your child's lunches (including packed lunch) on School Money. Nursery parents only need to book lunches for the days that their child will stay for lunch please.

Please ensure that you make all bookings for lunches by midnight on the Sunday before the start of the week as the system then closes down for the office to collate numbers and children's requirements for that week.



PE Kits

Please ensure your child has the correct PE kit in school for their lessons. All children should bring their PE kits to school on a Monday and leave them in school until Friday, when they can take it home to be washed.

Please ensure your child has suitable named PE kit for indoor and outdoor lessons. Your child will need a pair of trainers for all PE lessons. Please ensure children have tape to cover earrings if worn.

School Uniform

Please see below for a reminder of our school uniform policy.

Our school uniform consists of:

Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan (with or without the school logo)

White or navy-blue polo shirt

Black trousers, skirt or dress

Black tights, black or white socks

In summer, a plain blue and white gingham school dress can be worn or black school shorts with no additional colours, badges or adornments.



Footwear

School footwear is appropriate black shoes, plain black trainers may be worn.

PE Kit

Plain black shorts, plain white T-shirt and trainers or plimsolls

Outdoor games kit includes a warm jogging top, tracksuit bottoms and trainers suitable for outdoor use.

All clothing and shoes should be labelled with your child's name.

Hair that touches a child's shoulders must be tied up. Patterned shaved hairstyles and dyed hair are not appropriate for school.

Jewellery should not be worn as there is a danger that it may be caught on equipment. Children with pierced ears should only wear small, plain stud earrings with no adornment which must be removed or covered with surgical tape for PE lessons. Children may wear a watch but no smart watches are to be worn. No nail varnish or make up is allowed.

Home/School Communication



Please be aware that we will no longer be using the messaging facility on Class Dojo. Instead, we kindly ask that all communication with school staff, including to Mrs Lawson, is directed through the school office, either by phone, in person or via email.

We ask that in the first instance you speak to the class teacher or telephone the school office. If you have an urgent matter, please email the school office on

office@wawneprimary.co.uk This inbox will be monitored during school hours.

Teachers will still be available on the playground before and after school should you wish to pass on a quick message. This will help us make sure that important information reaches the right person and can be responded to promptly.

Class Dojo will still be used to share updates and celebrate children's learning, so please do continue to check the app regularly.

Breakfast and After School Club

Our wraparound care provision made a great start at the end of the summer term and this will continue from this week. Booking is available via School Money. If you wish to book your child into the club, please ensure you have completed and returned the Wraparound Care Contract and Contact Form.

As the provision will be run by school staff, the times and fees will be as follows:

Breakfast Club- 8am-8.50am £3.50 per child per session

After School Club- 3.30pm-5.30pm £6.50 per child per session



Payment must be made before your child attends the club and children can be booked into either club up to midnight the night before. We hope that families will support the provision so that we can keep make it a long term childcare provision to support all of our families. Fit4Fun sessions

We are very excited to say that the fantastic coaches from Fit4Fun will be joining us every Friday morning throughout the school year to deliver a range of sports as part of our PE curriculum. These sessions will be on a rota system with each class having allocated times throughout the year. This term it will be Class 1 and Class 3 who will be taking part in Tag Rugby lessons.

Children can come to school in PE kits for these sessions. Please make sure your child has trainers as they will be outside for these sessions.



School Car Park

Please be reminded that the school car park must not be used by any parents, carers or families when dropping children off or collecting children from clubs. This includes breakfast, after school, Kids with Bricks and gymnastics club.



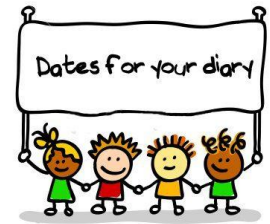
Nursery parents collecting children at 12pm are also reminded that they should not use the school car park when collecting their children at lunchtime.
