School Lunches

Halloween Disco

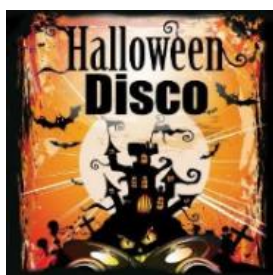
On Wednesday 22nd October, the PTFA will be holding a Halloween Disco in the school hall. There will be two discos:

Breakfast and After School Club

If you wish to book your child into the club, please ensure you have completed and returned the Wraparound Care Contract and Contact Form.

As the provision will be run by school staff, the times and fees will be as follows:

Breakfast Club- 8am-8.50am £3.50 per child per session

After School Club- 3.30pm-5.30pm £6.50 per child per session



Payment must be made before your child attends the club and children can be booked into either club up to midnight the night before. We hope that families will support the provision so that we can keep make it a long term childcare provision to support all of our families, at the moment we are at risk of losing the after school provision due to the low uptake of places.

Absence Reporting

Please can we remind parents/carers that if you are requesting a leave of absence from school for your child/children then an absence request form needs to be completed **before** the period of absence from school takes place. We have strict policies and procedures that we have to follow in line with the DFE Working Together to Improve School Attendance guidance. We work closely with the Educational Welfare Service to ensure that all absences from school are accounted for.

School Car Park

Please be reminded that the school car park must not be used by any parents, carers or families when dropping children off or collecting children from clubs. This includes breakfast, after school, Kids with Bricks and gymnastics club.



Nursery parents collecting children at 12pm are also reminded that they should not use the school car park when collecting their children at lunchtime.

Please use the roads around the school to park and walk into school. This is to avoid congestion and for health and safety reasons.

Following a recent local authority health and safety site inspection in school, we have had to make changes to our arrangements.

The children will all design their own Christmas card in school.
