Family Support

As part of a broader review of services provided to children and families within the East Riding Local Authority, we are pleased to announce that the Family Help School and Community team will be offering appointment-based 'drop-in' sessions at Wawne Primary School.

These 30-minute sessions are available to parents/carers who wish to discuss any concerns related to their child's behaviour, sleep patterns, emotional well-being, relationship difficulties, financial support, mental health, parental conflict, SEND, transitions, school avoidance or other relevant issues.

These sessions are available to all families attending our school. If you are unsure whether this session would be suitable for you, please do not hesitate to contact the school office for clarification.

The next drop-in session will be held on **Thursday 14th May 2.00pm-3.30pm**.

Breakfast and After School Club

If you wish to book your child into the club, please ensure you have completed and returned the Wraparound Care Contract and Contact Form.

As the provision will be run by school staff, the times and fees will be as follows:

Breakfast Club- 8am-8.50am £3.50 per child per session

After School Club- 3.30pm-5.30pm £6.50 per child per session



Payment must be made before your child attends the club and children can be booked into either club up to midnight the night before.

Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check

During the week beginning **1st June**, children in Year 4 will be taking part in the statutory Multiplication Tables Check (MTC). This is a short online assessment set by the government to assess children's recall of times tables up to 12 x 12.

The check is designed to help ensure pupils have a secure understanding of multiplication facts, which are essential for maths learning in Key Stage 2 and beyond. It consists of 25 questions, with a small amount of time to answer each one.

Children have been preparing in school and we encourage regular practice at home to help build confidence and fluency. Thank you for your continued support.

KS2 SATs Week



During the week beginning 11th May, our Year 6 children will be sitting the end of Key Stage 2 Statutory Assessments that will assess their understanding in Maths, SPAG and Reading. Throughout their time at Wawne Primary School, it has become clear that we have incredibly talented, kind, passionate and resilient pupils that we are all extremely proud of. There is no doubt that we have future scientists, authors, engineers, athletes and more. A separate letter has been sent out to all parents/carers of Year 6 pupils with further details.

Please note, it is vitally important that your child attends school on time and every day. Should your child miss a day of testing, they will need to be isolated from the rest of the year 6 pupils when they return to school. This isolation will remain in place until they complete any papers that they have missed. This will mean that pupils who miss days during SATs week will likely complete multiple papers on the same day.

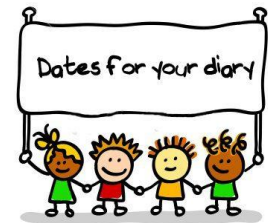
The arrangements above are a statutory requirement from the Standards Testing Agency to ensure that children do not receive information about test papers that they have not yet seen.
