Breakfast and After School Club

If you wish to book your child into the club, please ensure you have completed and returned the Wraparound Care Contract and Contact Form.

As the provision will be run by school staff, the times and fees will be as follows:

Breakfast Club- 8am-8.50am £3.50 per child per session

After School Club- 3.30pm-5.30pm £6.50 per child per session

Payment must be made before your child attends the club and children can be booked into either club up to midnight the night before.

Sports Day



Our annual Sports Day will be taking place on the school field on **Thursday 2nd July**. The children will be in their colour teams and will take part in various track events. **Parents/carers are invited to join us at 1.15pm ready for a 1.30pm start.** The afternoon will be organised by the fantastic coaches at Fit4Fun. Please ensure your child wears their colour t-shirt to school on that day with black PE shorts and trainers. All children must have trainers for safety reasons. Please can we ask that you send your child to school with a sunhat, water bottle and with suncream applied.

Children will be sat in a shaded area. Please can we remind parents/carers that they should stay in the designated spectator area and not come across to where the children are sitting. There are plenty of staff on hand to support the children.

Nursery children will be joining us outside at 2.45pm to do their race. Parents of Nursery children are invited to attend all afternoon if you wish or you can come along at 2.45pm ready to watch their race. They will be racing around 3pm. Any Nursery children who do not attend normally on a Thursday are welcome to come along in the afternoon with you. Please can they stay with you and then they can come and join their friends when it is their turn to race.

Our PTFA will be selling refreshments for parents/carers during the afternoon. Please bring cash for this. These refreshments are only for spectators and should not be given to the children during the event. We will have drinks and ice pops for the children.

Once the event is over, children will be able to leave with parents but no children will be allowed to leave early unless collected by their normal adult. Please let the school office know in advance if someone else will be collecting your child.

School Uniform

As we come towards the end of the school year, many parents start to think about getting uniform ready for the new school year in September. Please see below for a reminder of our school uniform policy.

Our school uniform consists of:

Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan (with or without the school logo)

White or navy-blue polo shirt

Black trousers, skirt or dress

Black tights, black or white socks

In summer, a plain blue and white gingham school dress can be worn or black school shorts with no additional colours, badges or adornments.



Footwear

School footwear is appropriate black shoes, not trainers.

PE Kit

Plain black shorts, plain white T-shirt and trainers or plimsolls

Outdoor games kit includes a warm jogging top, tracksuit bottoms and trainers suitable for outdoor use. **All clothing and shoes should be labelled with your child's name.**

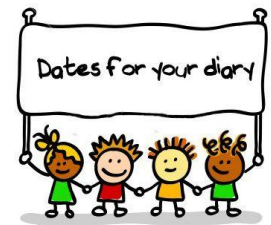
Hair that touches a child's shoulders must be tied up. Patterned shaved hairstyles and dyed hair are not appropriate for school.

Jewellery should not be worn as there is a danger that it may be caught on equipment. Children with pierced ears should only wear small, plain stud earrings with no adornment which must be removed or covered with surgical tape for PE lessons. Children may wear a watch but no smart watches are to be worn. No nail varnish or make up is allowed.
